

Invitation and Application to Join a Club Vision Facilitation Team

This is an invitation to be trained as a facilitator and become part of a District 6250 Club Vision Facilitation Team that will assist clubs in identifying their own vision, mission and values as a club. The Club Vision Facilitation Team walks clubs through a planning process that prepares the club for greater, more effective service as Rotarians. Training as vision facilitator will not only help you lead clubs through a planning process, but it may also have applications in your own business or other community organizations. One could pay a thousand dollars for this kind of training in a business setting, but our District will cover the cost for those selected for training. It is expected that if you are trained you will be willing to participate as part of a four member vision facilitation team for interested clubs in our District. Because 30 facilitators will be trained and teams of four will be working with a given club, this will not require more that 15 hours of any one persons time in the course of a year. Clubs that chose to participate in club vision planning will host the event, which is only 4 hours long. Club vision planning events will begin in January 2010.
