Before the scholar leaves

- Make the scholar an honorary member of your Rotary club

During the scholarship period

- Maintain regular correspondence with the scholar, in order to share news with fellow Rotarians and to enable the award recipient to relate news about the sponsor club to your club.
- Encourage the scholar to share concerns or problems experienced abroad. An award recipient may sometimes feel uncomfortable involving the host counselor in a sensitive issue, and will turn to you as a symbolic contact back home.

After the scholarship

- If possible, arrange to meet and welcome the award recipient home.
- Help the scholar arrange speaking engagements at your and other clubs in our district.
- Encourage the scholar's participation in any Foundation alumni activities available in the district in which she resides after the scholarship term.
- Maintain communication with the scholar and keep track of his/her current address.
