

## High School Summer Exchange

The Rotary Summer Exchange program is a Family-to-Family exchange for students age 15 to 18. Students submit their application by February 1<sup>st</sup> indicating their top 3 country choices and a match is established with an international family. The U.S. student spends 3-5 weeks abroad with the host family. During the same summer, the U.S. student hosts his/her host brother/sister in the U.S. Exact dates are determined by the two families.
